MCMO's 57th concert series offers world class performances by internationally-known musicians whose extraordinary talents communicate with deep emotion and blazing technical proficiency.

The Academy of St. Martin in the Fields Chamber Ensemble is the opening concert for this year, and the first of three new guest artists to appear on the series. The world-acclaimed English string octet, the most recorded chamber ensemble today, is known for its beloved classical repertoire performed with masterful tonal balance and interpretive refinement. Adding excitement to the opening concert is the Pre-Concert talk by Jamie Lamar. Mr. Lamar is a classical recording engineer and producer. As an Adjunct Professor at Boise State University, he frequently presents pre-concert talks for several chamber music societies. Please join him at the Museum at 6:30 PM for his remarks on the program to be performed that evening.

The second concert presents the young Schumann Quartett from Germany. Winners of international awards and competitions, they delight in the "performance experience" playing with high emotional intelligence and supreme technical accomplishment. The third new group is the Jerusalem Quartet. They are known for their sumptuous, unmistakable tone and adroit programming. To close the season, we welcome back the fabulous Hermitage Piano Trio who will present three piano trios from the great Russian repertoire.
